SuperMIND! – A Mindfulness-Based Relapse Prevention Workshop (4<sup>th</sup> run): 16 and 23 August 2024

These sessions were conducted for participants to be exposed to

mindfulness practices that enhance a sense of acceptance and assist in relapse prevention of addiction behaviours stemming from alcohol use disorder.





FundHEROES! (3<sup>rd</sup> run): 17 August to 7 September 2024

An intervention-based support group to educate participants to identify and challenge negative or irrational thoughts related to

finances, and to practice reframing these thoughts in a more realistic and positive manner through structured activities.

## **FRCS FCS Upcoming Activities**



<u>SuperME! – Men's Edition (2<sup>nd</sup> run): 16 October 2024 to 22 April 2025</u> This upcoming run of psycho-educational group for men will focus on addressing and exploring coping strategies as well as identifying protective factors for family issues that the participants are experiencing.



<u>SuperME!</u> – EmpowerHER (Pilot): 19 October to 30 November 2024 We will be running a support group for women with the aim of providing a caring and empowering environment where they can connect, share experiences, and support each other's personal growth.



SuperFESTIVE! (Deepavali 2024 edition): 26 October 2024

An initiative to support multi-challenged families during the festive periods where we will be bringing children aged 6 to 16 years old and their family members/caregivers out to purchase festive items. Prior to the shopping trip, we will be conducting a budgeting

workshop to inculcate financial literacy skills in the children.

Focused Intervention Team (FIT) for Early Childhood and Parenting (ECP)

Our FIT for ECP will be running a Parent-Child Grow programme for families with children aged 0 to 12 using Triple P (Positive Parenting Programme) framework. Slated to start from mid-October 2024, this initiative will run till January 2025 and involve monthly engagement sessions with parents/caregivers to equip them with techniques to promote their children's psychological, social and emotional competence.
